#### S/D 02-011 – One-step final plat Second Addition to Maize Park Cemetery

Platting of 5 acres for expansion of the Maize Park Cemetery located at 12733 W. 53<sup>rd</sup> street north. (½ mile west of 119<sup>th</sup> Street, south of 53<sup>rd</sup> street).

**Edgington** explained that the 5 acre area to be platted was for expansion of the Maize Park Cemetery. A drainage plan must be reviewed and approved prior to the plat being forwarded to the City Council.

**MOTION** Woodard moved to approve S/D 02-011 one-step final plat

(adjacent property owner) and had taken her to another site to see the crushing and recycling operation. **Mitchell** was satisfied after observing the crushing process.

*Martin* added that they wanted to work with the adjacent land owners and no concrete/asphalt crushing would be done on the weekend.
